

2024 Residents' Survey



Overview

Blaby District Council runs a Residents' Survey every two years alongside the annual budget/Council Tax questionnaire.


The 2024 Residents' Survey was done between 24 January and 25 February and contained 16 survey questions and seven optional equalities questions.

The survey was promoted through social media, via emails to parish clerks, through our emailed general newsletter and on our website. Some 210 hard copies were posted out and 50 were distributed to local centres, such as Braunstone Civic Centre and Sapcote Memorial Hall thanks to our Community, Business, Work and Skills Team.

According to consultation methodology, given the size of our population in the District, we needed 1,000 survey completions to be 99% confident, within a 4% margin of error either way, that the responses received represented the opinions of the population of the District.


We had 1,680 surveys returned, 1,628 online through our link to SurveyMonkey and 52 paper copies. Of these 1,276 (76%) were fully completed – that is all of the survey questions answered.

Here are the responses by village for 2024 as compared to 2022:




Overall, how satisfied are you with the way Blaby District Council runs its services?




We asked "Would you like to make any comments about services provided by Blaby District Council" – here is a word cloud with the most used words


Overall, how well informed do you think Blaby District Council keeps residents about the services and benefits it provides?




To what extent do you agree that services provided by Blaby District Council are good value for money?




Overall, how satisfied are you with your local area as a place to live?




How strongly do you feel you belong to your local area?




To what extent do you agree that people of different ethnicities get along in your local area?




Do you have a disability?




What is your age?
