

Local Plan Delivery Development Plan Document (DPD)

Examination Timeline

Blaby District Council submitted the Local Plan Delivery DPD Submission Version to the Secretary of State on 23 March 2018. The document was then the subject of an Examination by an independent Planning Inspector and, following modifications, was adopted by Council at a Full Council meeting on 4 February 2019. The details of the process are provided in date order below:

Submission

Blaby District Council agreed to submit the Local Plan Delivery DPD Submission Version at the Full Council meeting on 14 November 2017. Subsequently, Blaby District Council submitted the Local Plan Delivery DPD to the Planning Inspectorate on 23 March 2018. An independent Planning Inspector, Victoria Lucas LLB MCD MRTPI was appointed by the Secretary of State to determine whether the Local Plan Delivery DPD was sound and could be adopted by the Council.

Hearing Sessions

The Hearing Sessions took place between 31 July and 15 August 2018 at the District Council Offices in Narborough.

Main Modifications Consultation

Modifications to the Local Plan Delivery DPD were proposed by the Inspector. Public consultation on these proposed modifications took place from 14 September to 26 October 2018. The Inspector recommended that these modifications were required in order to make the plan sound.

Inspector's Final Report

The Independent Inspector of the Council's Local Plan Delivery DPD submitted her final report on the examination into the plan on 21 December 2018. The Inspector indicated that, subject to the recommended modifications, the Local Plan Delivery DPD complies with the requirements of the legislation and National Planning Policy Framework and is therefore sound.

Adoption of the Local Plan Delivery DPD

The Council made the Inspector's recommended modifications to the Local Plan Delivery DPD. The Local Plan Delivery DPD was then adopted at a Full Council meeting on 4 February 2019.
